

Impact report June 2026

Thank you so much for your support!

We are sending you this newsletter because your donation supports our veterinary clinic in Marsa Alam. Not all of our donors are active on social media, but we would still like to show you what your contribution makes possible:

In the first six months, we have already treated over 550 animals and administered 605 vaccinations, including 342 rabies vaccinations. We performed 76 parasite treatments, 60 disease tests (33 of which were for parvovirus), and 33 blood tests to determine rabies antibodies.

In total, we have facilitated 12 bone surgeries so that injured dogs didn't face amputations.

In addition, we have treated numerous other animals, such as a husky puppy that jumped from a balcony and was bleeding to death with a ruptured liver and spleen (but was saved by emergency surgery), bite and contusion wounds, amputations, a rope that had become deeply embedded in a puppy's neck, swallowed foreign objects, the removal of injured eyes and tumors, sick and abandoned kittens, and far too many cases of parvovirus.

We are especially pleased that we were able to find loving forever homes for 18 animals!

In the first half of 2026, we spayed/neutered 283 animals: a total of 185 dogs (102 females / 83 males) and 98 cats (51 females / 47 males).

Assuming that each unsplayed female will produce 16 offspring within a year (with children and grandchildren), with your help we have prevented 2,300 additional stray animals this year alone!

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These animals are spared life on the streets, scavenging for food in garbage, territorial fights, accidents and disease. It is estimated that only 20% of puppies and kittens reach the age of 6 months; fewer animals therefore mean less suffering.

Currently, over 95% of the dogs in downtown Marsa Alam are spayed/neutered and vaccinated against rabies. This is a crucial step in reducing conflicts between dogs and the local population.

Since we only started in November 2024, 2025 was a steep learning curve for us. In 2026, we adapted our treatment protocols to better help more animals, improved the clinic's responsiveness and communication, ensured meticulous documentation of every animal we treat and practiced strict budget control. We also expanded our team and now have a total of 12 people, including 4 veterinarians.

With this larger team, we managed our first spay/neuter campaigns outside of Marsa Alam, neutering dogs in El Quseir in May and cats at Lahami Bay Resort in June/July.
